

Student Travel Survey:

About

This survey gathers information on students' travel modes in order to inform the School Travel Planning (STP) program at . The STP program aims to improve students' journeys to school, by making them safer, healthier, and more sustainable. This voluntary survey is used to help our STP Committee gauge students' baseline travel behaviours. Thank you for your support!

Instructions for Teachers

- One survey sheet per classroom. Conduct survey with your class **once a day** (e.g., during morning attendance) over a one-week period.
- Ask students to raise their hands to indicate the main mode of travel they used for their journey *to* (Q1) and *from* (Q2) school. Students should only raise their hands once per question. For example: *“Raise your hand if you walked to school today - either all the way to school, or most of the way to school.”*
- Count and record the number of responses for each travel mode.
- After recording the answers to both questions, check that: the total # of responses + # absent students = total # students in the class.
- Return completed survey sheet to the school office at the end of the week.
